In accordance with 35 U. S. C. 301, I am citing my published abandoned application as prior art. MY APPLICATION # is 10/075,221.

Please compare my patent application Proprioceptive Device that Contains Nutrients for the Treatment of Statural Problems with the patent application Biomolecular Wearable Apparatus.

In 10/075,221 notice that Claim 18 states " A method of increasing muscle strength and endurance while conducting physical activity ( exercise) by wearing a nutrient holding device".

Notice that the means to this utility of increasing muscle strength is the same in both applications, namely holding the amino acids on the body utilizing a non transdermal holding device. The bench press trials in both applications are similar in design and come to the same conclusion.

The biomolecular wearable apparatus is a non-transdermal (waterproof) holding device and contains biomolecular ingredients. These ingredients are all nutrients (including amino acids) regardless of their levorotatory or dextrorotatory orientation in space. This invention claims to increase muscle strength by wearing the apparatus. (holding device)

My invention's apparatus is a nutrient holding device in which the nutrients including amino acids are encased in a non-transdermal waterproof housing. My invention claims to increase muscle strength when it is worn. (wearable)
